

To the Public Utility Commission of Texas:

I am a Texas resident and visitor to Texas State Parks, and I respectfully oppose the A3 route of Oncor's proposed 765 kV Dinosaur–Longshore transmission line.

Dinosaur Valley State Park is a treasured destination for families across North Texas. Its natural beauty, wildlife habitat, and world-renowned dinosaur tracks make it unique among our state parks. Routing a massive transmission line along the park's eastern and southern perimeter would permanently alter the landscape and wildlife habitat, diminishing the visitor experience for Texans who value this special place.

Reliable infrastructure is important, but it should not come at the expense of irreplaceable public lands when alternatives exist. I urge the Commission to reject the A3 segment and select a route that does not impact Dinosaur Valley State Park or the Paluxy River corridor.
